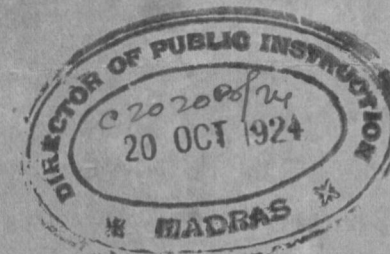
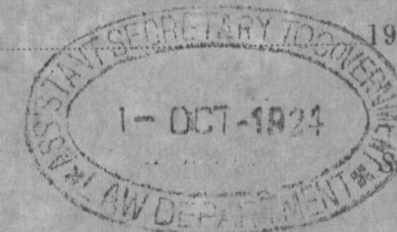

Sir,

With reference to G.O.No. 1327 Mis., dated 15th August 1924, I have the honour to state as follows:--

It is stated that only 24 pupils had been newly brought into school since the course of the year after the introduction of compulsion. But the latest figures supplied to our office by the District Educational officer now show that 133 pupils have been newly brought under instruction within 31st March 1924. Figures are as follows

Boys of school-age in March 1923 is 679

Boys of school-age in March 1924 is 812.

So pupils newly brought under instruction is 812-679 = 133.

At the time when this reference was replied to the Deputy Inspector of schools figures were available only partially for some schools within the Municipal limits. The District Educational Officer was addressed about the incompleteness of these figures and the present figures were received on 15-7-24.

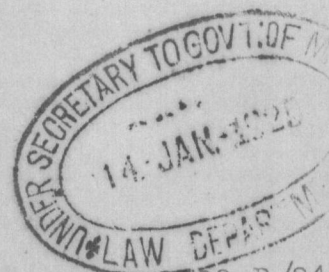
So 133 pupils have been newly brought under instruction after the introduction of compulsion in this Municipality. Pupils to be brought into schools are therefore (1006-812) 194 only. Leaving out of account 10 pupils who are exempted, about 184 are yet to be brought under instruction. More vigorous attempts will be made during the course of this year to bring others also within the fold of compulsion.

With reference to para 2, I have the honour to state that the opening of new schools will also be considered in the current year after the adoption of more vigorous steps. The pupils yet to be brought into school are not in a particular locality or ward but they are distributed all over the wards and portions of the Municipality. These could go into some school or another in any of the existing schools in the wards and this fact will be seen more clearly as more vigorous steps are taken in the direction of compulsion, this year. In this connection I have to remind that one new school was opened in last year, 1923-24.

In answer to para 3, the Government have been ~~already~~ approached for subsidies, for the construction of additional school buildings recently.

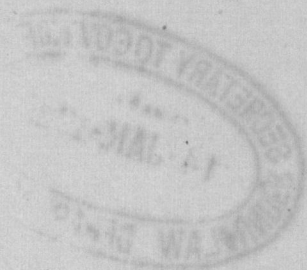

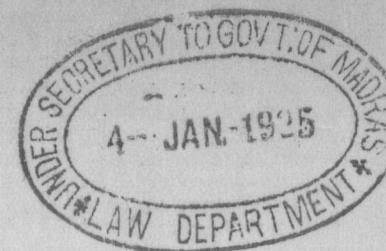
