Clause (a).

This relates to institutions under public management. Holidays to this class of educational institutions are governed by rule 77 of the Madras Educational Rules. The gazetted holidays for 1924 and the holidays mentioned in this rule have been compared and it is found that except for the fact that certain holidays which are special for Muhammadans are not allowed to Hindu schools and vice versa, all the gazetted holidays are provided for in the Educational Rules. It seems sufficient to refer the Hon'ble Member to the rule on the subject. ~~The 'Empire' day is also~~

Clause (b).

So far, it has not been thought necessary to lay down hard and fast rules regulating holidays in aided schools nor is there need to frame such rules now.

2. The following draft answers are submitted:-

(a) Holidays in educational institutions under public management are governed by rule 77 of the Madras Educational Rules which lays down separate sets of holidays for Hindu & Muhammadan schools. ~~Altogether all the gazetted holidays find place in both or either of these sets.~~ The answer is in the negative.

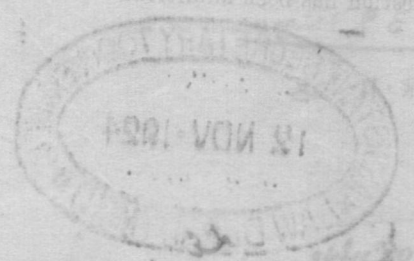

Observance of gazetted holidays by aided institutions.

1326 Q.—Mr. J. A. SALDANHA: Will the hon. the Minister for Education be pleased to state—

(a) whether the gazetted holidays, including Sundays, are observed in all Government schools and colleges, municipal and district and taluk board schools; and

(b) with reference to answer to question No. 699 given on 11th October 1924, whether Government contemplate passing orders that aided institutions should observe all gazetted holidays, as well as any others required by the religion of the majority of the pupils in each school?

A.—(a) Holidays in educational institutions under public management are governed by rule 77 of the Madras Educational Rules which lays down separate sets of holidays for Hindu and Muhammadan schools. Almost all the gazetted holidays find place in both or either of these sets.

(b) The answer is in the negative.

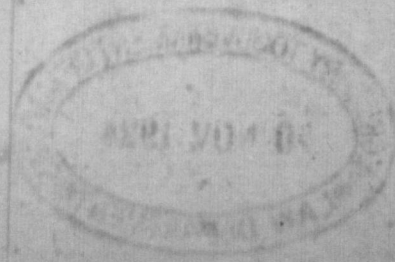
