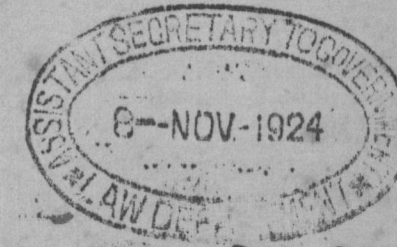

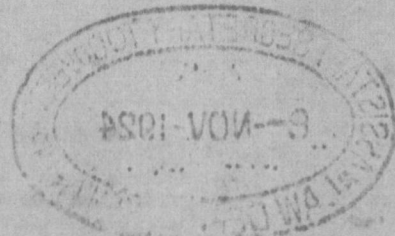

1512. Will the hon. the Minister for Education be pleased to state

(a) whether the Government are contemplating an increase in the scale of salaries of the officers in the Subordinate Educational Service; Rs 125-5-150-10-250. The Director has recommended that the pay of the service may be raised from Rs 125-5-150-10-250 to Rs 150-10-250.

(b) if not, why not; and fixed at Rs 150-10-250.

(c) if the answer to clause (a) is in the affirmative, whether definite proposals will be made by the Government before the next Budget Session? The present pay of the service is Rs 75-5-100-10-150 (with a selection grade on Rs 150-10-250).

A.S.P. twenty-five per cent of the cadre). The Association has requested that the pay of the service may be raised to Rs 100-5-150-10-250 or that the selection bar may be removed. The Director has not supported the first request, but has recommended the second one.

(c) L.T. School Assistants.

The present pay of this branch of the service is Rs 75-5-100- for 18 per cent of the cadre, Rs 100-10-150 for 40 per cent of the cadre. The Association has requested that the pay of this branch may be raised to Rs 100-5-150-10-250 or that the two bands on Rs 100 and 150 may be removed. The Director has recommended the second alternative.

2. The question of the revision of the pay of the service was first ordered to lie over pending issue of Anderson the Lee Commission's report.

Clauses (a) and (b) of the question.

The non-gazetted Educational Officers' Association recently submitted a memorandum praying for a revision of the pay of the subordinate educational service. The requests of the association are as follow:-

(a) Subordinate Educational Service, Collegiate Branch.

The pay of the service may be raised from Rs 125-5-175-7½-250 to Rs 125-12½-250. The Director has recommended that the pay may be fixed at Rs 120-10-250.

(b) Deputy Inspectors.

The present pay of Deputy Inspectors is Rs 75-5-100-10-150 (with a selection grade on Rs 150-10-250 for twenty-five per cent of the cadre). The Association has requested that the pay of the service may be raised to Rs 100-5-150-10-250 or that the selection bar may be removed. The Director has not supported the first request, but has recommended the second one.

(c) L.T. School Assistants.

The present pay of this branch of the service is Rs 75-5-100- for 48 per cent of the cadre, Rs 100-10-150 for 40 per cent of the cadre. ^(+ Rs 150-10-250 for 12 p.c. of the cadre) The Association has requested that the pay of this branch may be fixed at Rs 100-5-150-10-250 or that the two bars on Rs 100-and 150 may be removed. The Director has recommended the second alternative.
