Report on the working of weaving class attached to the Board Higher

Elementary school, Bhuvanagiri.

Date of establishment.
Period of instruction.

27th November 1922

2 sessions of two periods of 50 minutes each per week in classes III to VII

Whether products sold and amount realised

40 towels of varying length and breadth and pattern are manufactured but they are not yet sold.

Age of children who work at looms

Children who are 9 years old and upwards work at the looms.

Appliances

3 looms, 2 Frame looms and one pit loom are fitted up at present. There are also one beaming machine one drawing in machine and one board warping frames Which the pupils are constantly using.

Instructor.

A secondary grade trained teacher, who has also undergone training in weaving at the Govt. Textile Institute Madras has been appointed on Rs.35 per mensem.

Pupils.

All 116 boys from the 3rd to 7th standards are attending the weaving class Out of these only 30 per cent actually handle the looms. The rest receive theoretical instruction in minor operations such as winding, joining out threads straightening of hanks warping etc

Nature of instruction imparted.

All operations done by local weavers such as straightening of hanks, warp making sizing, Drawing in, beaming, twisting in repairing broken threads, weaving and tracing defects in weaving.

Accommodation

A separate thatched shed measuring 30' by 20' has been constructed for the location of weaving class. All the looms and other machines are fitted up there.

Conclusion

On the suggestion of the District Educational Officer who visited this institution on 9-8-1923 a well qualified Instructor has been appointed. The shed has also been made safe, by erecting teak wood fences all round it. With the advent of the new Instructor and with the contemplated ^{employment} of a qualified attender the weaving class is bound to have a bright future.

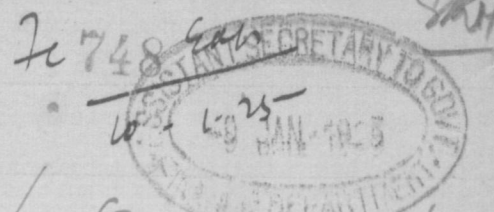

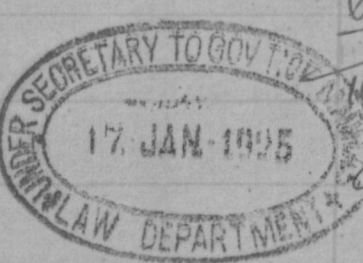
