Sir,

Mr. H.O. Kershaw, Inspector of European Schools, Madras whose sphere of duty extends over the whole of the Madras Presidency stayed at Ootacamund for a period of 43 days from the 16th June 1924 for the inspection of the schools on the hills. He carried with him his Motor car and maintained it at Ootacamund for his camp use and claimed the cost of transport of the Motor car and for servants under rule 45 (b) of the Madras Travelling Allowance Rules. As a copy of the Audit Officer's Manual referred to in the above rule was not available in the Office, the travelling allowance bill of the Inspector of European Schools was referred to the Accountant

General for preaudit with reference to the scale prescribed in the Audit Officer's Manual. The Accountant General has stated that the audit Officer's Manual is under compilation and that ^{Pending} ~~preaudits~~ its issue the scale prescribed in the Madras Supplemental to Civil Service Regulations at page 234 should be considered in force. Since however the Inspector of European Schools has not been included in the list, the Accountant General thinks that special sanction of Government should be obtained to extend the concessions of rule 45 (b) of the Madras Travelling Allowance Rules to Mr. Kershaw- (vide copy of his letter enclosed)

2. In these circumstances, I have the honour to request the orders of Government as to whether the Inspector of European Schools, Madras who is a Presidency Touring Officer will be included in the Audit Officer's Manual and a scale prescribed for him.

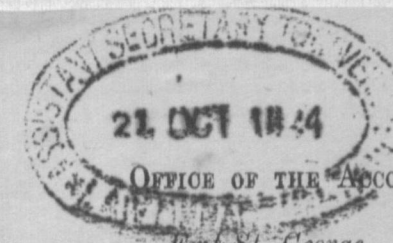

In returning herewith the travelling allowance bill received with your letter No.R.O.P. 26-D-17/24, dated the 21st August 1924 I have the honour to state that the Audit Officer's Manual is under compilation. Pending issue of the Manual the scale prescribed in the Madras Supplement to the Civil Service Regulations at page 234 should be considered to be in force. As the Inspector of European Schools has not been included in the list, special sanction of Local Government should be obtained to extend the concessions of Madras Travelling Allowance rule 45(b) to Mr.H.O.Kershaw.

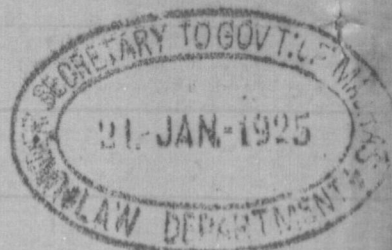
