I have the honour to report that the Committee in the

Allowance of Rs.100/- per mensem to Reverend W.R. Ramshaw from

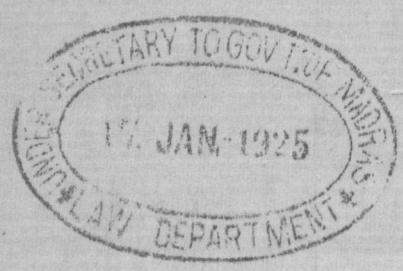

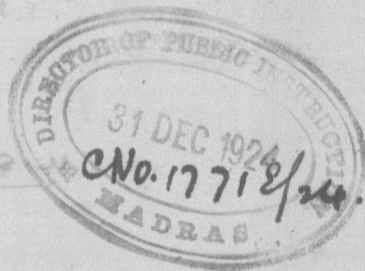

From the papers with G.O. N. 317 of 29.2.24, it will be seen that Mr. Ramshaw was appointed to carry on the duties of ~~Principal~~ Principal during the ^{absence} ~~absence~~ of Mr. Padfield ^{on leave} and that he was given an allowance of Rs. 200 a month in addition to his pay ^(Rs. 600) during that period. He would thus have drawn a salary of Rs. 800 a month till the 21st Oct. 1924, when Mr. Padfield rejoined after the leave. The committee has not given any reasons as to why it is proposed to give him a temporary allowance of Rs. 100 a month from that date. Apparently it is intended to protect him ^{in pay} from ^(effect of his) the reversion which reduces his salary from Rs. 800 to Rs. 600. As
