Sir,

It is reported by the District Educational Officer, Tinnevelly, that the Municipal Council, Tinnevelly, which has introduced compulsion with effect from 1-1-23 has not yet maintained a register of children of school-age resident in the several wards of the municipality and has also not constituted an Attendance committee. In reviewing the report on the working of the scheme, it was pointed out to the chairman last year, that the maintenance of a register giving complete particulars in regard to children of school age and the constitution of an Attendance committee are quite essential to the successful working of the scheme. Under G.O.No.364 Law

(Education)

No report appears to have been received by Govt. last year.

Education dated 23- 3- 22 the standing committee constituted under the District Municipalities Act can discharge the functions of an Attendance committee, if authorized by the municipality.

2. In these circumstances, I have the honour to request that the council may be directed to take immediate action towards these two items.

3. It is also reported that out of the 15 municipal schools, only one school has a pukkah building of its own, 3 schools are held in temporary sheds erected by the municipality and the others are in rented buildings. It is understood that 3 buildings will be constructed in the year 1925- 26.

18,000 in its Elementary Education Budget for the year 1925--26
for the construction of school houses. The work will be put on
hand shortly and the fact intimated to Government in due course

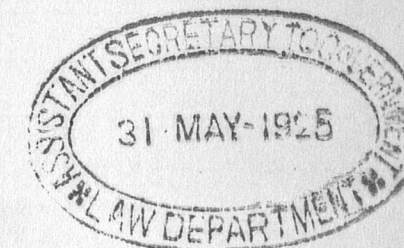
