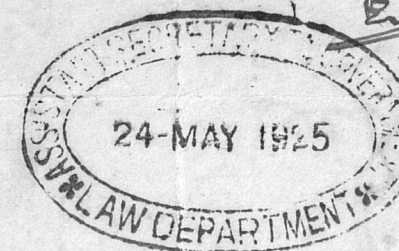

Sir,

I have the honour to report that including the amount of Rs.4,796 sanctioned for the Madras District Educational Council in G.O.No.410 Law (Education) dated 23rd March 1925 the total amount received for distribution as Teaching Grant for the year 1924-25 is Rs.1,43,164 while the aggregate amount sanctioned by the Council amounted to Rs.1,47,325. The reason for exceeding the actual resources is, the delay in sanctioning the supplement coupled with the real cause of such delay and the consequent natural expectation of a larger amount than that specified above being granted as supplement.

There is now a deficit of Rs.4,161 and nine paise.

have yet to be paid the teaching grant for 1924-25.

I am directed by the Council to request the Government to place this amount as early as possible at the disposal of the Council as advance grant for the year 1925-26 so as to enable the Council to pay the whole of the teaching grant sanctioned for the year 1924-25.

2. The reason assigned for exceeding the allotment placed at the disposal of the council is not acceptable. When the question of placing additional funds at the disposal of the District Educational Councils was under the consideration of Government, the President, District Educational Council Madras, should have either awaited the receipt of further orders or distributed the amount available pro-rata as required in rule 2 of Chapter I of the rules framed under section 42 (2) of the Madras Elementary Education Act. The request of the President is strictly inadmissible as no provision for the purpose is made in the Civil Budget Estimate for 1925- 26. But as nine managers appear to have been paid no grant at all, I recommend that the advance of Rs.4161 applied for may be sanctioned subject to the warning that the amount so paid may have to be deducted from the amount payable to the council for 25- 26.

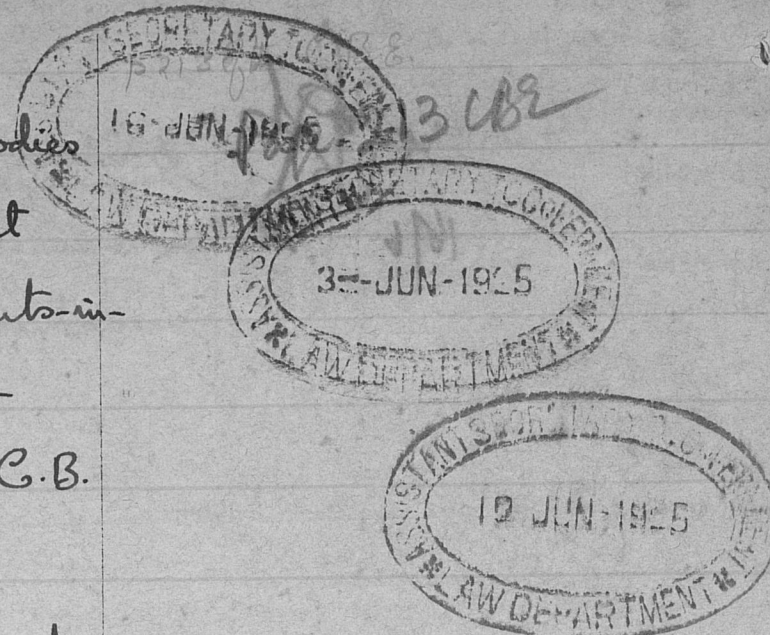
