Sir.

The hostel attached to the Sarvajana High School, Peelamedu, is at present held in a rented building and the authorities of the school have submitted an application for aid under Rule 43.A of the Grantⁱⁿ-Aid-Code towards the rent for the hostel building.

There are at present 24 members of the hostel and the rent paid for the hostel building is Rs.480 per annum. A rent of Rs.4 per annum is collected from each student residing in the hostel and the Manager of the School states that almost all the hostel boys are very poor, some of them

being

being supported by charitable gentlemen and that the maximum amount that can be collected from each of them is only Rs.4 per annum. The District Educational Officer, Coimbatore & the Nilgiris, recommends that the rent to be collected from each student residing in the hostel may be fixed at Rs.4 per annum and I support the District Educational Officer's recommendation.

I have therefore the honour to recommend that Government will be pleased to fix the rent to be collected from each student residing in the hostel at Rs.4 per annum.

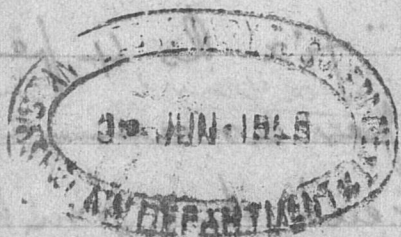

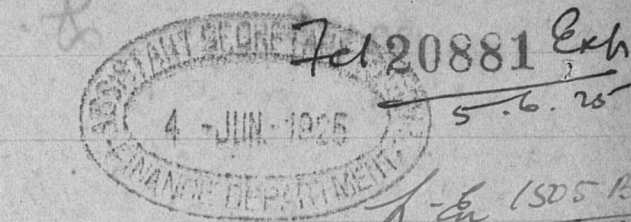
