In submitting herewith an extract from the proceedings of the municipal council passed at its meeting held on 23rd March 1925, I have the honour to state as follows:--

Balambapuram is a village situated about three quarters of a mile from the nearest municipal school. It is inhabited mostly by Adi-Dravidas and other depressed classes and a few Muhammadans. It is found impossible to induce the people of this village to attend the schools in the interior of the town

The Deputy Inspector of schools, Karur and the District Educational Officer, Orichinopoly strongly recommend the opening of a separate school for the village.

The Municipal council has decided to give effect to the scales of pay mentioned in G.O.No.1212 dated 24th July 1924 to all teachers of the elementary schools under it and as such the expenditure under elementary education has considerably increased. The council cannot finance the opening of an additional school at present. I therefore request that the Government may be pleased to sanction a recurring -- grant for opening an elementary school at Balambapuram with one ---- teacher on Rs.20/- per mensem and initial equipments etc. at a cost of Rs.100/-.

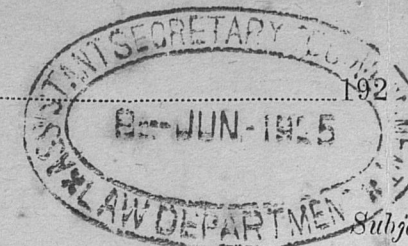

Sir, Resubmitted with reference to Government endorsement No. 9914-1 L & M, dated 6th April 1925.

2. It is observed that the Council should be able to meet this small expenditure involved in the present -- proposal from its own funds. In G.O. No. 976, Mis. Law (Education) dated 16th June 1924 approving the budget estimate for 1924-25 of the elementary education fund under the control of the council, its contribution from the general revenues was fixed at Rs 7765. It is reported that the Council has actually contributed only a sum of Rs 6808. The balance of Rs 957 will have to be credited
