I have the honour to forward herewith for
necessary action, a copy of letter No. M/1573, dated
the 10th December 1924, from the Superintendent,
Central Jail, Trichinopoly, together with its - -
enclosures, from which it will be seen that the
Head Master, Government Training School, Dindigul,
has violated the repeated instructions of Govern-
ment and placed an order for furniture with a local
contractor even though the jail rates were compara-
tively cheaper than that accepted by the

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school.

Copy of letter No. M/1573, dated the 10th December 1924,
from A.J. Nicholas Esquire, B.A., Superintendent, Central
Jail, Trichinopoly.

I have the honour to report that the Head Master,
Government Training School, Dindigul asked me to quote for
certain articles of furniture in his letter R.C.No.227,
dated the 19th October 1924. Quotations were accordingly
given in this office No. 1342, dated the 5th November 1924,
and a reminder was sent from this office on 27th November
1924 asking whether he has accepted the quotations. He
replied in his letter R.O.C.No.227, dated the 2nd December
1924 stating that orders were given to a local supplier.
He was requested to furnish the rates at which the orders
were placed locally and a copy of his letter in reply is
enclosed herein.

I enclose a statement showing the quotations furnished
by the Jail and the local contractor referred to for compari-
son. In this connection I wish to point out that this
Officer has overlooked the instructions conveyed in G.O.

D No. 491, dated the 23rd February 1922 and I therefore request
that necessary steps may be taken in the matter.

Copy of letter No.R.O.C.227 dated the 8th December 1924 from the Head Master Government Training School, Diindigul, to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Trichinopoly.

Subject:- Local rates of articles of furniture.

Reference:- Your R.O.C.1513 dated 3rd December 1924.

I have the honour to enclose the rates of the local contractors at which the order was given, as directed by you. This contractor has been supplying articles of furniture etc., to this institution and to most of the local government offices, Local Boards and other institutions. As the amount of the order is very small and as there is the consideration of the railway freight and the possible damage to the articles during transit, the order was given to the local contractor. Also, the punkah and the pulley have to be fitted up here for which work I must seek the aid of some man here. I requested for the quotation as I was directed by the District Educational Officer to do so. I was not aware of the Government Order that I should write to giving the local rates. However, this will be certainly remembered in future.

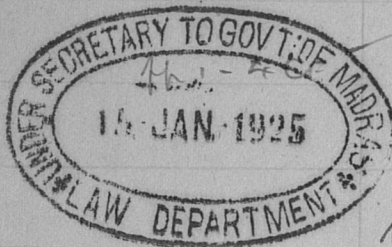

From the J.G.'s letter and enclosures

There appear to be no justification for
the H.D. Master, Govt Training School, Dindigul
to purchase the articles required for the
school from local contractors instead of from
the Jail. Quotations for jail made
articles were called for by the H.D. Master
only and they are much cheaper than
the local rates. The reasons set forth in
the H.D. Master's letter on p. 4 of for his
preference of the local made articles do not
appear to justify his action. Attention is
invited to the series of orders issued in
this department regarding the necessity
for Govt consuming departments to purchase
from jail so long as serviceable articles of
the kind required can be obtained at a
reasonable price from them.
