Sir,

I have the honour to state that Miss. G. Yesudial permanent Headmistress, Government Girls School Villupuram, from 8-11-20 to 15-8-22 on Rs. 40 plus 12 per mensem ^{was} transferred to the Government Girls School, Chidambaram as Headmistress of the school on the same pay. She held the latter post from 16-8-22 till 11-2-23. While doing duty in the Government Girls School, Chidambaram, she was confirmed as an Assistant in the Government Training School for Women, Conjeevaram with effect from 27th October 1922 without prejudice to her officiating appointment in the Government Girls School, Chidambaram. In 1923 Miss. Nesamani Ammal a permanent

permanent teacher of the Government Middle School for Girls, Salem was appointed as headmistress of the Government Girls School, Chidambaram and Miss. G. Yesudial was therefore asked to join her substantive appointment as an assistant in the Government Training School, Conjeevaram. She was relieved in the Government Girls School, Chidambaram on the afternoon of 11-2-23 and joined duty in Conjeevaram in the forenoon of 19-2-23.

2. In their order No. 292 Law (Education) dated 24-2-23 the Government have sanctioned the transfer of the Government Girls School, Chidambaram to the control of the municipality with effect from 1-2-23 and at the time of transfer of Miss. Yesudial it was not known that the Government Girls' School, Chidambaram would be transferred to the Municipal control with retrospective effect.

3. The initial pay of the teacher was originally fixed at Rs. 57 on 1-3-22 on the ~~same~~ basis of the pay of Rs. 52 per mensem drawn by the teacher during the test period as Headmistress of the Government Girls' School, Villupuram. But as the Government Girls' School, Villupuram, was an Elementary school, not admitted to the time scale, the initial pay already fixed on behalf of the teacher had to be revised. The pay of the teacher was accordingly fixed at Rs. 54 on 19-2-23 i.e. the date on which she actually joined duty in the Government Training School for Women, Conjeevaram, in a time scale post and she was allowed to draw her next increment from 27-10-23 under Fundamental Rule 26(a) and (e) as she was confirmed in a time scale post with effect from 27-10-22. The Accountant General approved of the pay fixed on behalf of the teacher in his letter Edn-961 dated 3-1-25 but stated that the sanction of Government was necessary for the deputation of the teacher under

under foreign service conditions under Fundamental Rule 110 in his letter No. Edn. 1-7 dated 6-4-25.

4. Mrs. Devanugraham Dhanaraj nee Miss D. Gnanamuthu is another teacher who was employed as 1st Assistant, Government Girls' School, Chidambaram on Rs. 30 plus 10 from 15-8-22 to 11-2-23. This teacher was confirmed as 5th Assistant, Government Secondary and Training School, Cuddalore on Rs. 30 plus 10 with effect from 27-10-22 without prejudice to her appointment in the Government Girls' School, Chidambaram. She was subsequently transferred as permanent Assistant, Government Training School for Women, Conjeevaram, on Rs. 40 plus 12 and she joined the post on 17-2-23. The initial pay of this teacher was originally fixed at Rs. 54 with effect from 17-2-23. As her promotion to a post on Rs. 40 plus 12 was made after 30-11-22 the initial pay of this teacher was refixed at Rs. 45 ~~per mensem~~ ^{from} 17-2-23 and she was allowed to draw ^{the} next increment from 27-10-23 as she was confirmed in a time scale post on 27-10-22. In her case also the period from 1-2-23 to 16-2-23 will have to be considered as on foreign service under Fundamental Rule 110.

therefore
5. I request that in the case of these two teachers, you will be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government for their deputation on foreign service conditions from 1-2-23 to 19-2-23 and 1-2-23 and 16-2-23 respectively and to remit the pensionary contribution to be paid by them under Fundamental Rule 119(a)

6. No arrears of pay are due to the two teachers for the period during which they were employed in the Government Girls' School, Chidambaram, as the time scale of pay in the case of these ~~two~~

these two teachers will take effect only from the date of their joining the time scale posts in the Government Training School, Conjeevaram, and as the posts held by them prior to their joining the Government Training School, Conjeevaram, carried a fixed scale of pay. The excess pay drawn by these teachers according to the initial pay originally fixed on their behalf will be included in the consolidated statement to be submitted to Government.

There is no audit objection to Government sanctioning the loans of the services of Miss.C.Yesudial and Mrs.D.Daraj to the Municipal Girls' School, Chidambaram, for the periods from 1-2-1923 to 19-2-1923 and from 1-2-1923 to 16-2-1923 respectively on the pay they would be eligible for under Government service.

3. Contribution for their leave salary and pension payable to Government is one-fourth of their pay in Foreign service unless Government, in the circumstances explained in para 5 of the Director's letter under reference, is pleased, under Rule 119 of the Fundamental Rules to remit the contribution due.

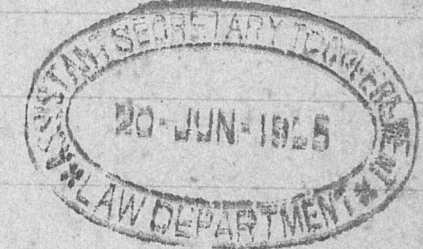
