Application for exemption from the Examination Rules of an unpassed candidate for employment in the office of the Superintendent of Police, South Kanara.

1. Name, age and educational qualifications of the unpassed candidate, for whose exemption sanction is sought.

1. B.M. Shabuddin, age 46 years.
Lower Secondary examination.

2. Mary Gonsalves, age 29 years.
Fifth form and elementary type-writing.

(1) Clerk B.M. Shabuddin has put in a service of over 22 years and draws Rs. 47. He belongs to the backward community of Muhammadans and is the senior in the lower grade of clerks. (2) Mary Gonsalves, an Anglo-Indian is the next in rank to him drawing the same pay. She has put in a service of over 8 years and is the only lady clerk in the Police Department. The Superintendent of Police reports that their work is satisfactory and the Deputy Inspector-General of Police states that both of them are deserving of the concession. I strongly recommend their exemption.

Subject: Exemption from examination rules.
The D. G. recommends that B. H. Shaliden
and Mary Gonzales, clerks on Rs 47 in the office
of the Supt of Police, S. Kanara, may be
permanently exempted from examination rules
for employment on Rs 60.4.80 grade.
It is not known when and upto what pay
the former was granted exemption. As regards
Mary Gonzales, it may be said that she
was originally a typist on Rs. 20-1-25 and
was subsequently granted exemption for
employment in the clerical posts on pay
not exceeding Rs 50/- per mensem (via G.O. 714 Home
(En) of 7.6.19.)
In view of the strong recommendation
of the D. G., the exemption applied for may be
sanctioned. The remarks of the Judicial Dept
may, however, be invited in the first instance.
