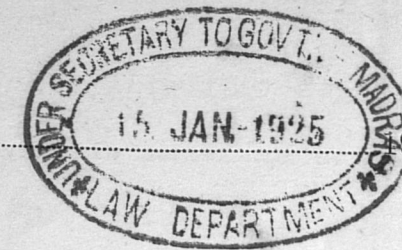

Sir,

With reference to Government Law (Education) Memo No. 2478 B-2, dated 3rd October 1924 and in continuation of my letter R.O.C.No. 160 A/24, dated 20th November 1924 regarding the introduction of the tender system of supply of provisions etc to the Reformatory and Senior certified school, Chingleput, I have the honour to submit herewith for the approval of Government a form of notice and a form of agreement prepared by the Government Solicitor, Madras. It is proposed that while the agreement with the contractors may be signed by the Director ^{on behalf of} ~~for~~ the Secretary of State for India in Council, the tender notice may be issued and tenders accepted by the Chief Inspector of Certified Schools, Madras. I consider that

a responsible officer such as the Chief Inspector should call for tenders.

In regard to the advantages that will accrue should the system of supply of provisions by means of tenders be introduced, the Superintendent of the school observes that at present all the articles are purchased in the local market whenever -- required at varying rates and that this procedure not only places the school at the mercy of one or two local contractors who invariably demand exorbitant prices, but also makes the estimates and regulation of expenditure under rations difficult and uncertain. The special officer for contingencies who conducted recently the audit of the accounts of the school endorses this view and I have little to add to the recommendations of these two officers. I may however mention that I propose introducing the tender system in the Junior Certified School, Ranipet also with effect from the next financial year.

It is requested that the forms of tender and agreement may kindly be returned when done with.

Remarks of the Special Officer on the
Contingent expenditure of the Reformatory School
Paragraph 10. Further savings possible by the
invitation of tenders.

Rations are now purchased monthly from the local bazaar at the prevailing market rates, the system of inviting tenders not being in force in the school. The present Superintendent has addressed the Director of Public Instruction for permission to invite tenders for the next official year and there is no doubt that the invitation of tenders at the harvest season will secure better average rates than the present system of purchase at the prevalent market rates. This will be patent from the following prices paid in the school from month to month in 1923 for the more important articles of rice and dhal and the contract rates in force in the Vellore Central Jail for 1923-24.
