As the sanction accorded in G.O.No.695 Law (Education) dated 7-5-24, for the retention of the temporary Assistant Lecturer in charge of Languages other than English (in the Subordinate Collegiate Service) employed in each of the Government Arts Colleges at Rajahmundry, Anantapur and Kumbakonam expires on 30-6-25, I have the honour to request that in the circumstances explained hereunder Government will be pleased to sanction the permanent retention of the three posts with effect from 1-7-25.

2. The three posts of Assistant Lecturers were created some six years ago and have been continued on a temporary basis up till now. The reasons for their creation are set forth in the Director's letter R.C.No.8370/18 dated 20-6-19 disposed of in G.O.No.906 Home (Education) dated 22-7-19 and they still hold good. I consider that so long as the nature and quality of the work continues to be the same as that detailed in the Director's letter mentioned supra and as long as the three Colleges are affiliated in the groups referred to in the letter the continuance of the Assistant Lecturers is necessary.

3. The following statement shows the number of students studying Languages other than English in the several groups of the B.A. course during the last six years and the number anticipated in 1925-26.
