As there is no other clerk in the office who has passed the Accounts Test which under Forest Code Section 68 is necessary for holding the Accountant's post, I desire to submit this further reference. D. Jagannadha Rao has filled the post for the last six months from 25-7-24 to my satisfaction. He has been working in my office for the last 8½ years. The Board in its Proceedings Routine No. 1470, dated 27-3-24 was pleased to permit him to rise in the time scale of 35-60 up to Rs. 50/1).

In these circumstances I request that the Board may be pleased to exempt him for a period of one year. D. Jagannadha Rao, though a failed matriculation candidate, is above the average of S.S.L.C. holders in point of general knowledge and intelligence. He has passed all the special tests prescribed for Head Clerk's and Accountant's posts of District Forest Offices.
