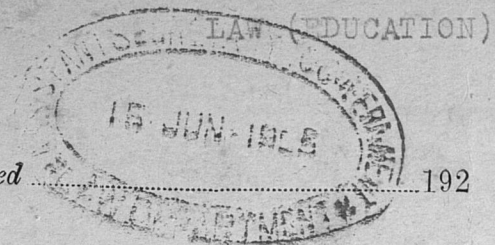

Sir. The Superintendent of the Government Junior Certified school, Ranipet has brought to my notice that a boy named Govindaswami who was admitted into the school on 10th December 1924 has developed signs of leprosy and that he is a source of great danger to the other inmates in the school. The boy has neither any parents nor any home. He is now kept in isolation in the local hospital and in the interest of the boy, the Superintendent of the school reports that he should be removed to the Leper Asylum at Chingleput. In these circumstances, I have the honour to request that Government will be pleased to order the removal of the boy to the Leper Asylum at Chingleput in the first instance
