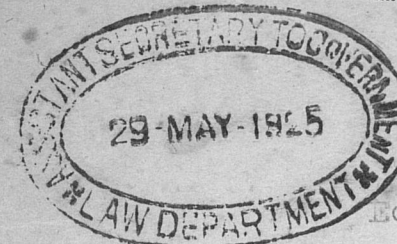

Sir. Under the rules relating to educational concessions to the children of deceased or incapacitated soldiers, Government in their Order No. 1270, Law (Education) dated 4th August 1924 sanctioned the payment of Rs 49/- on account of tuition fees and other incidental expenses of Pleasance May Smith for the year 1924 in St. Joseph's Convent European Girls' High School, Coonoor. The Inspector of European Schools reports that application for renewal of the concession for the year 1925 has been received and that the amount required is Rs 54/- being Rs 39/- for tuition fees and Rs 15/- for incidental expenses. I have the honour to request the sanction of Government for payment of this

amount.

2. The expenditure may be met from the provision under "31 R.B.(b) Education-Secondary-Direct grants to Non-Government Secondary Schools-European Boarding grants" in the Budget Estimate for 1925-26.

3. I further request that I may be empowered to sanction renewal of the concession for this pupil for future years if necessary.

Educational concessions - Pleasance May Smith -

For the W.S.

The concessions sanctioned in G.O.No.663 Home (Education), dated 23-5-1918 apply to children of Indian soldiers. In paragraph 6 of the Government of India's letter forwarding the scheme of educational concessions that Government stated that it might be made applicable, with such modifications as Local Governments deemed fit, to the children of European and Anglo-Indian soldiers. Under this discretion, the Government sanctioned the payment on behalf of Miss Smith, the daughter of a deceased Anglo-Indian soldier who died in the war, of grants to the schools in which the girl was studying from 1920-to 1924 -- Vide G.O.s No. 192 Law (Education), dated 8-2-1924 and 1270 Law (Education), dated 4-8-1924. The D.P.L. now recommends that the grant may be renewed and asks for sanction to the grant of Rs. 54 (Rs. 39 for tuition fees and Rs. 15 for incidental expenses) to the management of the St. Joseph's Convent European Girls' School, Coonoor, in which the girl is reading. He also requests that he may be empowered to sanction the renewal of the grant for future years, if necessary. The proposals of the Director may be approved. A draft order is submitted. It may be sent to Finance for acceptance.

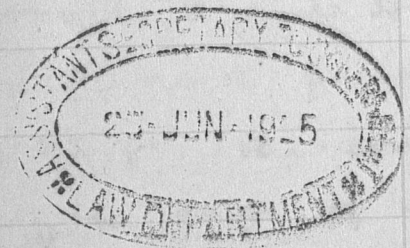

① Similar concessions are admissible to Indian children under § 663 of 23.5.18 which is applicable ^(as specific sanction) mainly to them & under the proviso in each individual case. Under proviso to rule 4 on p. 2 of the § and paragraph 5 of the §, the concession in the case of Indian children may be continued without any reference to the Govt.

② No such case is traceable from the Indexes. But in the absence of original file here, I am unable to give a definite reply to this
