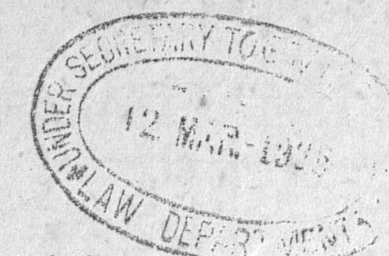

(b) whether it is a fact that the Government have no information as to whether the Corporation of Madras are being fed now; if so, the fund from which the expenses are met?

669.Q :-Mr. R. Veerian : - Will the hon. the Minister for Education be pleased to state : -

(a) whether it is a fact that a G.O.No. 1890, dated 3rd December 1924, was passed to the effect that no expenditure should in future be incurred on the feeding of pupils in elementary schools from the Elementary Education Fund under the control of the presidents of taluk boards, chairmen of municipal councils and the President, Corporation of Madras; and

(b) whether it is a fact that the poorer class of pupils in elementary schools of the Corporation of Madras City are being fed now; if so, the fund from which the expenses are met?

A. (a) Yes.

(b) The Government have no information. The order in question has been communicated to the Corporation of Madras.

Mr. R. Veerian : - Sir, with reference to (a), may I know whether Government have suggested to the local bodies any other source from which they can obtain money for feeding the pupils of the depressed classes?

The hon. Rao Bahadur Sir. A.P. Patro : - "It is open to local bodies to utilize funds specified for this purpose."

Mr. S. Satyamurti : - "May I know the reasons why Govt. have passed this Government Order?"

The hon. Rao Bahadur Sir. A.P. Patro : - "Because it was referred to them".

Mr. S. Satyamurti : - I am not questioning the power of the Government. I am only asking the reasons which prompted the Government to pass an order prohibiting the use of the funds for feeding the poor pupils, which is very necessary if the poor pupils are to be educated.



The hon. Rao Bahadur Sir. A.P. Patro : - Government realize that it is very necessary; but they say that the fees which were levied for certain specific purposes must be utilized for those purpose only."

Mr. S. Satyamurti : - "Have Government set apart or do they propose to set apart any other funds for the purpose?"

The hon. Rao Bahadur Sir. A.P. Patro : - The local bodies have to raise funds".

Mr. S. Satyamurti : - "If the local bodies raise funds, will Government also help them in giving elementary education?"

The hon. Rao Bahadur Sir. A.P. Patro : - "Grants for elementary education are guided by rules already published".
