Sir,

With reference to G.O.No.976 Mis., Law (Education Department) dated 16-11-1924, I have the honour to enclose herewith an extract from the proceedings of the Municipal Council passed at its meeting held on 12-3-1925 deciding to grant with effect from 1-4-1923 a substantive addition of Rs.3/- to the salary of each of the trained Mistresses of the Municipal Higher Grade Elementary School for Girls, Karur, which was handed over to the Council by Government in G.O.No.292 Law (Education) Department dated 24-2-1923, in lieu of the capitation allowance that was being paid at the same rate which was abolished in G.O. No.1164 Law (Education) Department dated 3-10-1922. This is a school

the whole cost of which is met from Provincial subsidy. The annual allotment for the payment of capitation allowance is Rs.396/- In G.O.No.165 Law (Education) Department Rs.667/- is shown as savings from the Elementary Education subsidy. This is made up of the capitation allowance of Rs.396/- due for 1923-24 for the Higher Grade Elementary School for Girls and the savings which were the result of some posts being vacant during the last year in the school. As the capitation allowance due for 1923-24 becomes usually payable only in 1924-25 the sum of Rs.396/- should not have been taken as "savings" and deducted from the subsidy due for 1924-25. In the audit report for 1923-24 it will be seen that this is not shown as savings. As the Council has now decided to merge this allowance in the salaries of the mistresses as per G.O. No.1164 Law (Education) dated 3-10-1922 as it is their just due, I have the honour to request that Government may be pleased to refund the amount of Rs.396/- deducted from the subsidy due for 1924-25. The actual addition to pay during the year 1923-24 worked on the above criterion amounts to Rs.331-3-7.

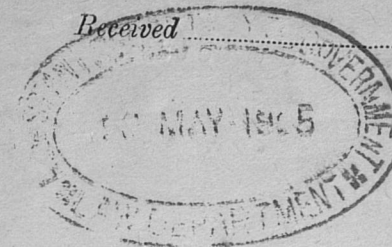
