committee placed the scheme in
class III; and as no provision
was made for it in the budget,
the Govt. directed that the scheme
be postponed for the present and
asked the D.P.O. to bring it again
for consideration in connection
with the budget for 1926-27.

2. The Director now
proposes that the Form may be
opened in the current year. From
the letter at p. 1 of (D), it will be
seen that there is a ^{strong} case for
opening it in the current year.
As regards addl. staff, it is now
proposed to employ only one
addl. graduate assistant and
to incur an expenditure of
Rs. 850 for initial equipment. The

It is also stated that this addl.
expenditure can be met by
reappropriation, and that it can be
sanctioned by the D.P.J. himself.
3. It is submitted

That, in the above circumstances,
the Govt. may sanction the opening
of Form VI in the school from
1st July 1925. As an analogous
case may be cited that of the
opening of Form IV in the Govt.
Islamicah Secondary School,
Trichinopoly. In that case, the
Finance dept. agreed to the opening
of the Form as the extra expen-
diture could be met by reappro-
priation and to the issue of
orders in anticipation of the
approval of the Fin. committee;
and thereafter, to the scheme
being placed before the committee.
Submitted that, in view of its extreme
urgency, a similar procedure
may be followed in this case also.
There is no time to await a formal
official communication from the
D.P.J.

NOTE FOR THE FINANCE COMMITTEE

Subject - Government Secondary school for girls, Vellore - Opening of form VI

The Government sanctioned the opening of Form V in the Government Secondary School for girls, Vellore in 1924. To complete the development of the school into a High school Form VI should, in the usual course, be opened in the year 1925. The Director of Public Instruction accordingly submitted proposals for the opening of form VI and they were placed before the Finance Committee as a Part II scheme for 1925-26. The Committee placed the scheme in class III and Government ordered the scheme to be postponed for consideration in connection with the budget for 1926-27.

The Director of Public Instruction however urged the necessity for opening Form VI in the current year and pointed ^{out} that the extra expenditure amounting to Rs 1530/- on account of the appointment of a graduate assistant on Rs 75/- plus Rs 10 a month and equipment charges (Rs 850) could be met from the sanctioned allotment for the current year. The Government sanctioned the proposal in G.O.No.1142 Law (Education), dated the 1st July 1925. A copy of it is communicated to the Finance Committee for information.
