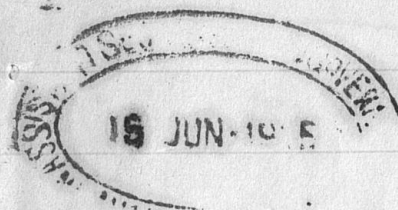

In article 2 of the P.S. Notifu., under the jail dept., the appointments of Chief and Reserve Head warders are exempted from the Examination rules. The scales of pay of these appointments are in Rs 30-1-40 and Rs 40-2-60. Mr. A. Bazely has been confirmed as European Warden at Rs 80-2-100. The appointments of European Warders have not been exempted from the Examination rules, in article 2 of the P.S. Notifu. The sanction of the Govt. is therefore necessary in the case of Mr. Bazely. It however the Govt. include the

appointments of European Warders in the table under article 2 of the P.S. Notifu, as desired by the J.G. Mr. Bazely need not be specifically exempted for appointment as European Warden.

2 The Est. Dept. may be requested to issue orders as desired by the J.G. on p 4 ante. If this is done, Mr. Bazely will receive the mean of his pay, 12 up to Rs 100.

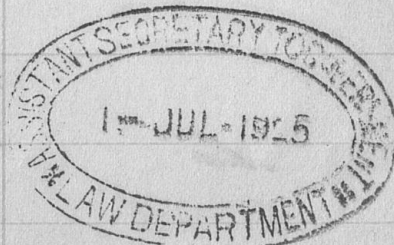
