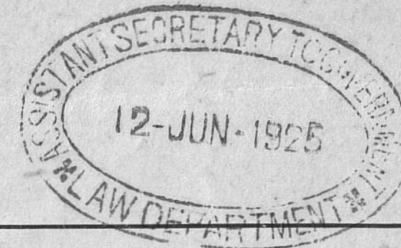

Subject:- Medical inspections of pupils
in Secondary Schools.

I have the honour to invite a reference to G.O. No. 641 Law (Edn) Department dated the 29th April 1925 passing orders on the above subject.

2. It will be seen from para 1 (6) of the above order that fees realised from pupils in Government institutions should be paid to the medical officers along with Government share. It is apparently intended that the fees realised from pupils should be retained by the head of the institution until they are disbursed to the medical officer. As the procedure is opposed to Treasury order No. 7, it is suggested that such fees are credited in the first instance to a detailed head "Medical Inspection fees" and re-drawn in a separate bill Civil Account Code Form No. 13 when the amount is required for disbursement to Medical officers. 3. The rates fixed by Government are maxima. It is presumed that the actual rates payable will be fixed by the Director of Public Instruction by a general or special order. As regards the grants payable to local bodies and private managements it is presumed that the grants will be sanctioned by the Director of Public Instruction on receipt of report required by para 2 of the order.
