Sir,

I have the honour to request you to be so good as to address Government regarding the grant of Passages and Over-Sea Allowances to Officers of European domicile in the Provincial services and beg to point out that while, as a result of Lee Commission, concessions in this direction have been made to the All India Services, nothing has been done for officers in Provincial service though their position is infinitely worse than that of the officers to whom this concession has been granted in as much as the former have already less pay while their expenses and home remittances are no less.

In my own case I would point out that I am of a European domicile, born, bred and educated in England, that all my relations except my wife and young children are in that country. I have been in India for over 20 years during which time I have never been in a position to visit any of my family and owing to heavy expenses I have had a continuous struggle against debt, so much so that, if I were to die to-morrow, my wife and children would be left without so much as a three pie bit to live on.

Some years ago I insured my life but owing to increasing expenses it was impossible for me to continue to pay the necessary premiums so that the insurance had to lapse.
