Temporary Allowance to teachers - Contribution from Taluk
Board Fund.

The Director of Public Instruction has, in his Proceedings
H.C.No.679-B/23, dated 10th December '23 and 14th March '24, sanc-
tioned subsidies amounting to Rs.5137/- from Provincial Funds -
towards the payment of Temporary Allowance at Rs.4 per mensem to
teachers under this Board -- Rs.2717/- towards the payment of the
allowance for 1923-24 and Rs.2420/- towards that for 1922-23.

The allowance for 1923-24 was paid in March '24, while, that for
1922-23 was deferred for payment during the current year, as the
subsidy relating to it was received rather late in March '24. This
Board having agreed to abide by the condition laid down in G.O.

No.226 (Law) Education, dated 27th February '23 in regard to the
payment of an equal amount of contribution from its fund, had to
contribute, from its General Revenue taken credit for in its

revised estimate for the current year, a sum of Rs.2660 towards
the payment of this allowance in addition to the usual contri-
bution of Rs.2840/- to be paid to the "Elementary Education Fund.

The District Board, Malabar, has, with a view to wipe off the
deficit of this Board and to secure a surplus balance in the
budget for 1925-26, reduced the Board's contribution to Elementary
Education Fund for the current year (ordinary & capital) from
Rs.5500 to Rs.2480, and disallowed this Board to contribute any-
thing towards the payment of the allowance in question during this
year. As necessary steps have already been taken to dis-
burse the allowance to the teachers before the end of this month

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this Board resolved to apply for permission from Government to pay this allowance. A copy of the Board's resolution on the subject is enclosed. In these circumstances I beg to request that you will be kind enough to move the Government in this matter and to obtain their permission to utilise the savings available under "Elementary Education Funds", towards the payment of this arrear allowance to teachers as a special case, if the reduction made by the District Board in the revised budget estimate of this Board for 1924-25 is accepted by the Government.

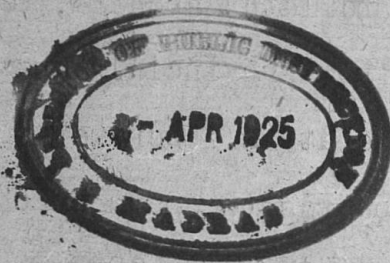

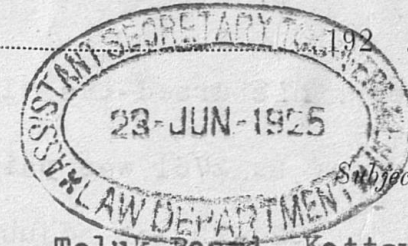
