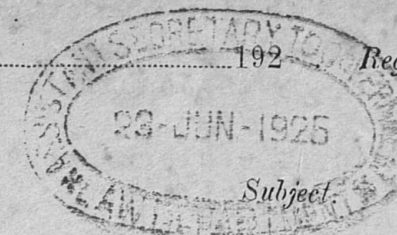

The shorthand writer of this office has passed the higher grade examination in Typewriting held in November 1924 and his success in that examination was published in the Fort St. George Gazette, dated 10th February 1925. On the recommendation of the Director, Government sanctioned the grant of a special pay of Rs 10/- on his behalf in G.O. No. 708, Law (Education), dated 5th May 1925. The Accountant General now states that under Article 232 of the Civil Account Code the order can have effect only from 5th May 1925, the date of the G.O. Government passed orders in May 1925 though the Director's recommendation for the grant of the special pay was made in this office letter R.C.No.36 F/25, dated 7th March 1925 soon after the publication of

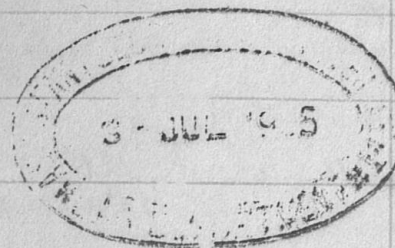
