Sir,

I have the honour to address you as regards the
exemption from examination rules of M. Balasubrahmanya
Mudali, acting clerk in the District Registrar's office,
Cuddalore.

2. The acting clerk is the son of the late M.R.Ry.
P. Manickavelu Mudaliyar, B.A., who, as the Head clerk
and Manager of the Forest section of the Board of
Revenue (Land Revenue) about 20 years ago, had earned
a reputation for honesty and efficiency and rendered

meritorious services to the Government. The officer who belonged to a respectable family died while in harness after a few days' fever, leaving his widow and child Balasubrahmanyam destitute. Thanks to the generosity of a few friends who took upon themselves the maintenance of the boy and his mother. The boy received education up to the V Form in the Chengalvaroya Naicker's Orphanage School and could not continue his studies further owing to poverty. In April 1924, M. Balasubrahmanya Mudali applied to me for a clerk's post and I ordered the District Registrar of Cuddalore to provide him with an acting clerk's place, having regard to the services rendered by his father and the respectability of his family.

3. The candidate has thus been appointed an acting clerk and put in an acting service of more than a year during which period he has given entire satisfaction both as regards work and conduct, judging by the report received from the District Registrar of Cuddalore. He is found to possess the attainments deemed sufficient for discharging the duties of a clerk.

4. Under G.O. No.722, Law (Education), dated the 13th June 1922, I am empowered to sanction the employment of unpassed candidates in appointments carrying a salary of Rs.35 to Rs.60 in the mufassal and Rs.40 to Rs.65 or Rs.80 in the Madras city, provided bona fide efforts were made without success to obtain passed candidates; but as the conditions of the proviso are not satisfied in this case, I am precluded from sanctioning the exemption. In the circumstances, I request that the Government may be pleased to sanction, as a special case, the exemption of the acting clerk M. Balasubrahmanya Mudali from the provisions of Article 1 of the Public Service Notification with a view to his being appointed

as a permanent clerk in this department on a pay of Rs.35--60 in the mufassal or Rs.40--65 in the city.
