College has been granted 5 months leave with effect from the date of reopening of the college after summer vacation. I have in my letter R.C.No.509 C/25 dated 14-5-25 recommended the keeping of the Indian Educational service post of Professor of English in the Queen Mary's college in abeyance, during the absence of Miss.K.M.Myers on leave and to create instead a temporary post in the Madras Educational Service (Womens branch).

(3) I propose to appoint Miss C.M.Cavanagh who is now officiating as Assistant Professor of English in the Madras Educational Service to the temporary post to be newly created.

(4) I am unable to make suitable proposals to fill up the post of Assistant Professor of English in the Queen Mary's college in the Madras Educational Service (Womens branch) until I know definitely the date of Miss.Philipsz' return from England and I therefore request that you will be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government to hold in abeyance the post of Assistant Professor of English in the Madras Educational Service (Womens branch) for a period of 3 months and to create instead a temporary post in the Subordinate Educational Service (collegiate branch) - (Womens branch)

The Principal desires that the College should have the full sanctioned staff from the date of reopening. If the post in the M.E.S. is not held in abeyance as recommended, it will have to be filled up temporarily by some one until the return to duty of Mrs. Lakshmi Ammal. This will be about the middle of August 1925. The main reasons for recommending the holding of the post in the M.E.S. in abeyance are that Mrs. Varghese, the present officiating lecturer, would be a loser by being appointed to the M.E.S. post and that I did not feel justified in recommending an outsider straightaway to officiate in the M.E.S. I consider that the post in the M.E.S. may be held in abeyance until Mrs. Lakshmi Ammal's return to duty instead of until the return of Miss Philipsz as originally recommended.

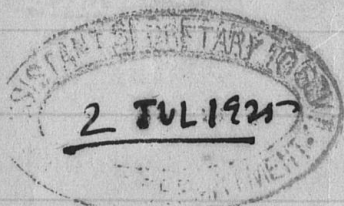
