The sum of Rs.17000 taken credit for in the Budget Estimate for 1925-26 as Government grant under the proviso to section 37 will be liable to subsequent adjustment, since the subsidy payable towards the temporary allowance of Rs.4 is to be based on the actual number of teachers employed by the board in 1925-26.

3. With reference to the board's contribution from its general revenues entered in the actuals of 1923-24 and in the Revised Estimate for 1924-25, attention is invited to the audit report recorded in G.O.No. 153 R.L.E., dated 15th April 1925.

4. As regards the utilisation of the lump provision of Rs.5000 included in the sum of Rs.25360 entered in the Budget Estimate for 1925-26, the board may be advised to consult the District Educational Officer specially in regard to the location of the new schools.

5. On the debit side of the budget under capital the board has ~~shown~~ shown Rs.1396 in the actuals of 1923-24 and Rs.840 in the Revised Estimate for 1924-25, while the corresponding entry under the same ^{year} time on the credit side for each of the years is only Rs.100. It is observed that the excess has been met from the 'ordinary' receipts, but the board has not indicated the same.

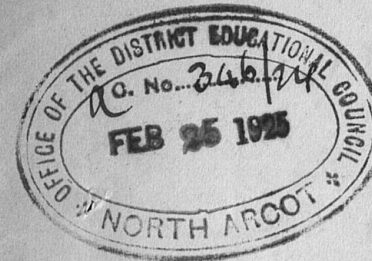
