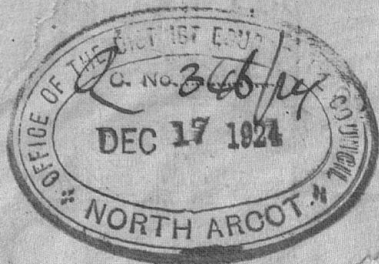

The pay of the existing teachers is not proposed to be revised. An extra provision of Rs 7000, is made to meet the increased cost, on account of increment to the teachers, and the opening of new schools.
