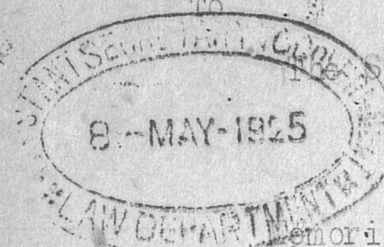

Memorial of Mr.N.R.Krishnamma of the Indian Educational Service, Madras.

Sir,

In continuation of this Department letter No.337, dated the 12th February 1925, I am directed to say that the Secretary of State for India in Council has ruled that the decision communicated in this Department letter No.1171, dated the 9th June 1924, should have retrospective effect to the date from which the orders modified by it came into force.

I am accordingly to request that the pay of Mr.Krishnamma and all other officers appointed to the Indian Educational Service, prior to the 1st December 1919, who were affected by the pause in the time-scale at Rs.600 per mensem, may be recalculated as if exemption from that pause had been granted to them from the outset.

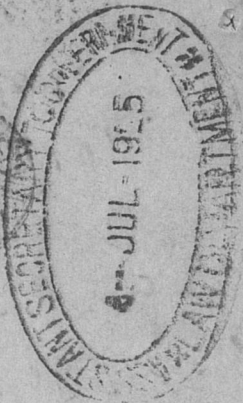

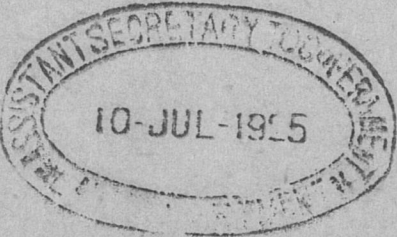
