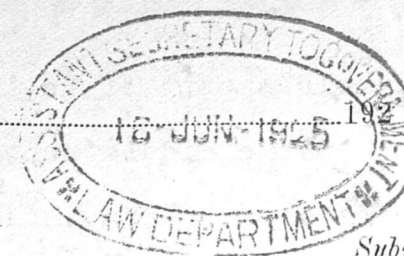

Sir,

I have the honour to state that the full net
cost of the middle school department of the Board High
School, Cherukunnu, in Malabar District, is met from
provincial funds and the high school department is
maintained from the Boards funds. At the beginning of
the present calendar year, the school sustained the loss
of a building and some furniture on account of a fire
accident. Consequently, the Malabar District Board
had to incur an expenditure of Rs.1,300 for constructing
a pandal for holding classes, for certain repairs to
buildings, which were damaged by the fire, and for
replacing the lost furniture, books etc. The President
District Board has addressed me request^{ing} sanction

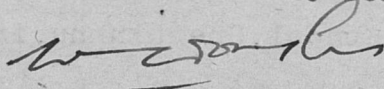
sanction to include the whole amount of Rs.1,300 spent, in the net cost statement of the middle school department for the year or to pay a provincial subsidy equal to that amount, on the ground that the present financial position of the District Board does not permit it to bear even a moiety of the cost from its own funds- please vide copy of the Board's resolution enclosed. The financial condition of the District Board as revealed in its Administration report for the year 1923- 24 is not so bad as represented by the President, District Board. The Board can well meet one half of the expenditure from its own funds. I recommend that the other half, viz Rs.650 may be permitted to be included in the net cost statement of the school for the year 1924- 25.

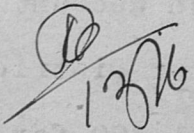
2. No separate provision has been made in the Civil Budget Estimate for incurring this expenditure, but it may be possible to meet this small amount out of the allotment in the current years budget for payment of teaching grants to Local bodies for the maintenance of Board and municipal Secondary schools.

Extract from the Proceedings of the District Board of Malabar passed at its meeting held at Calicut on Wednesday the 29th April 1925.

30. Read (1) Presidents letter R.O.C.No.77/C.25 dated 7th March 1925 to the Director of Public Instruction, Madras reporting that the District Board had to incur an expenditure of Rs.1,300 for replacing the furniture, books etc destroyed during the fire accident to the thatched shed attached to the Board High School, Cherukunnu, and for putting up a pandal to hold the classes which were till then accommodated in the above shed and requesting that this expenditure may be admitted when assessing the net cost of the school or that a subsidy may be sanctioned to cover the expenditure.

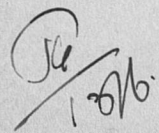
2. Endorsement N.R.O.C.No.140/D.25 dated 8th April 1925 of the District Educational Officer, Malabar, forwarding endorsement N.R.O.C.No.596-B/25 dated 30th March 1925 of the Director of Public Instruction requesting to furnish a detailed statement of expenditure of Rs.1,200 and a copy of the resolution of the District Board approving the proposal and agreeing to meet a moiety of the expenditure.

The Board requests that the entire expenditure may be met from Provincial funds.

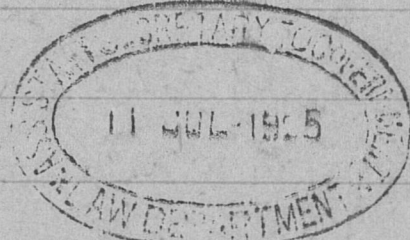
