I have the honour to state that on the recommendation of the District Educational Council, the Nilgiris, the Municipal Council has sanctioned a grant of Rs. 100 for the free supply of text books, slates, etc. to the poor of the depressed classes studying in the Municipal elementary schools within this Municipality, with the reservation that the books, etc. so supplied remain the property of the Council and should be accounted for by the Teacher concerned.
