Letter from E.B. Cobbald Esq., I.C.S., Collector of
Guntur, R.C.No. 4417-25-A-5, dated 18th May 1925.

M.R. Samuel is a lower division clerk and is at
present working as Labour Inspector. He is a panchama Christian
and served on the field during the Great War. He passed the
chain survey course and has not yet passed the Revenue Test.

In B.P. No. 2893 Routine, dated 11-7-1924, the Board was
pleased to sanction temporary exemption for a year and the
period of exemption expires with 24-5-1925. During the period
of exemption, he appeared once for the examination but failed

under art. 5(2) (iv)
of the Pub Service
Act (K)

to secure a pass. He could not apply for the examination to be held in June next, owing to domestic difficulties. The District Labour Officer, under whom he is working, reports that the individual has been doing his work satisfactorily.

In these circumstances, I request that the Board may be pleased to exempt him for another year from passing the Revenue Test, so that he may continue as Labour Inspector.

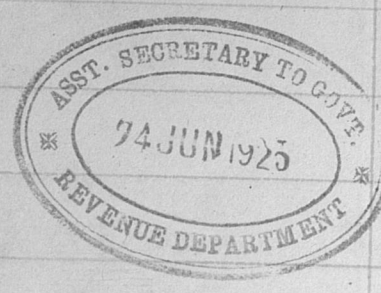

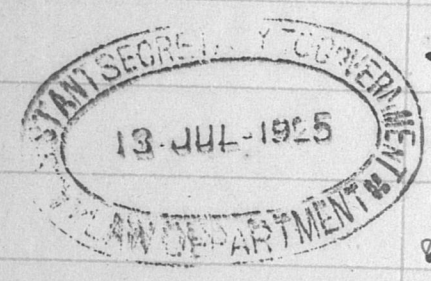

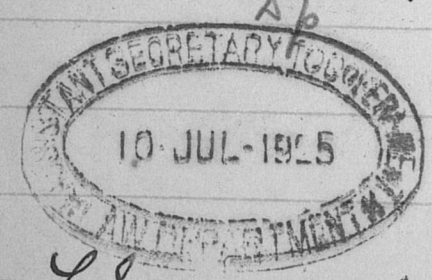
