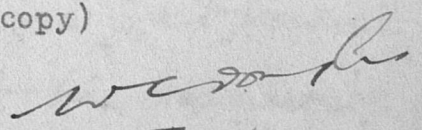
"In connection with your Proceedings R.C.No.866 D/25
dated 25- 5- 25, I have the honour to submit the following
report regarding the manner in which the use of a motor
car by me will serve the interests of the public service.

In addition to my ~~own~~ duties as Professor of
History, the Government have nominated me to the board
of trustees of the Madras and Suburban Town Planning
Trust, and I have also been appointed a member of the
Students' Advisory committee. The Principal of the
Presidency College has nominated me to serve on the
committee of management of the University Students
Club, which is maintained by Government. The possession
of a car will considerably help me in the discharge of
these duties.

I should also like to point out that I have been
given a ^{Commission} ~~concession~~ in the University Training Corps,
and have been appointed Adjutant of the corps. In this
capacity it is part of my duty to attend the parades
of the various college companies. These parades are
held on the ground of the various Madras colleges.
and almost ^{every} ~~by~~ evening ⁱⁿ ~~on~~ the week during term time I have
to be present at one or other of these colleges.

I am also a member of most of the bodies
constituted under the Madras Universities Act, and for
the discharge of these various duties the possession of a
motor car would be of considerable help.*

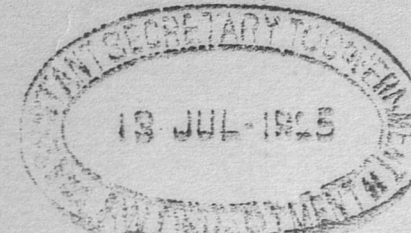
