(C) chargeable on advances sanctioned after the 1st July 1924. It has been ruled by the Govt of India that no interest should be charged on advances sanctioned before

the 1st July 1924, whatever may be the date on which it is actually drawn. The

currency of the first sanction in this case should be taken to run upto the 23rd June 1925 (i.e. one year from the date of sanction) with reference to Article 233 of the Civil Account Code).

That the Govt authorised a deviation in the object on which the advance was to be utilised does not seem to affect the case so long as their approval to the change was accorded within one year

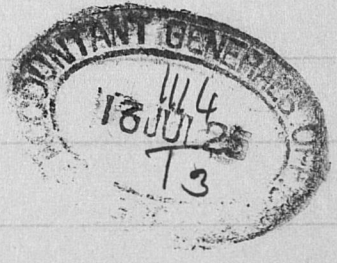
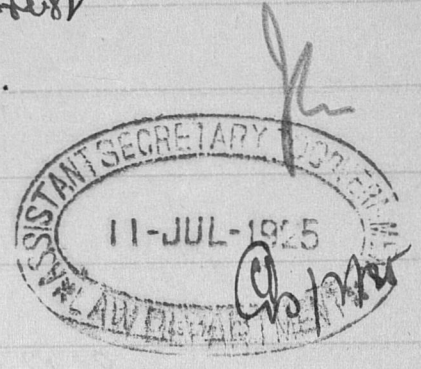
