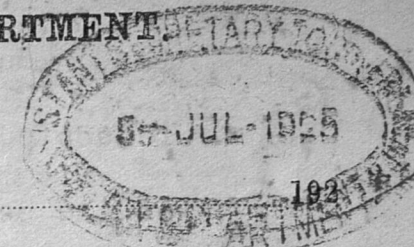

Sir.

I have the honour to report that the C.E.Z.Mission who manage the Gell Memorial Girls' High School at -- Fernhill, Ootacamund, is at present faced with financial embarrassment as the Home Mission has decided to stop their grant to the school from the end of June 1925. The Correspondent of the school reports that unless special aid is given by Government to the extent of the full net cost of the higher forms (i.e.) (IV,V and VI) during 1925-26. She will be obliged to close down those three forms and to run the school as a middle school only. The net cost of those forms is estimated at Rs 6250/- exclusive of income from all sources against which the school has earned an ordinary teaching grant of Rs 2821/- plus

Rs 500 as special teaching grant - Rs 3321 in all. There is thus a deficit of Rs(6250-3321) 2929/- which amount is requested as a special subsidy towards the maintenance of the school during 1925-26.

2. The Gell Memorial High School is the only institution that offers facilities for the higher education of Indian Girls on the hills, there being no other institution imparting secondary education in the Nilgiris District.

The school is very favourably reported by the Inspectress and I consider that the Indian Girls in the Nilgiris District should not be deprived of their chances of getting higher education which is sure to be the result if the higher forms of the Gell Memorial High School are closed down.

3. I therefore recommend that the special treatment prayed for may be accorded to this school for the current school year only, so that the high school classes may be continued this year. I have also informed the correspondent that the special aid will be given only for 1925-26 and that arrangements to run the school in future years will have to be made by the management.

4. I request that you will be good enough to obtain the sanction of Government for the payment of a special subsidy of Rs 2929/- to the school during 1925-26.

5. Incidentally, I may add that the Municipal Council, Ootacamund, has under consideration of proposal to start under its management a High school for girls at Ootacamund and it may be hoped that before the close of 1925-26 some solution for the provision of higher Secondary Education may be found so that Indian Girls in the Nilgiris may continue to have facilities for higher education.

6. The charge can be met from the provision of Rs 735200/- under 31 B(b) Education-Secondary-Direct grants to non-Government Secondary schools-Indian Schools in the Civil Budget Estimate for 1925-26.
