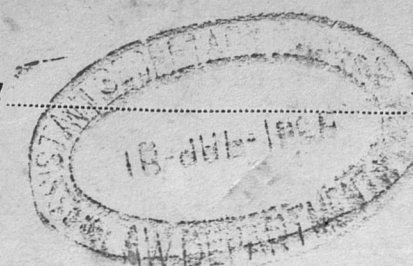

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refused to accept the Deputy Consulting Architects estimate for the well, I referred the matter to the Chief Engineer to Government, Public Works Department Buildings and Roads and he has estimated the cost at Rs.4000/- vide copy of his letter No.454 Wks A/25 C.R dated 23- 6- 25. I recommend that the scheme may be approved at a cost of Rs.4000 as estimated by the Chief Engineer.
