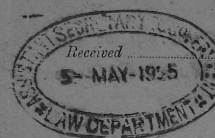

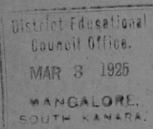

Nine new schools have been recommended by the Educational officers to be opened next year in the Taluk Board area, but as the funds of the Taluk Board are limited the opening of the 9 new schools next year will depend upon subsidy being found by Government towards the initial and recurring cost of the schools.

Total number of teachers employed in all the schools under the management of the Local body on the date of submission of the Budget, the scales of pay in force and the number of teachers in each scale.

(2) schools to be newly opened during the ensuing year, and their scales of pay.

one teacher is on Rs 30, one on Rs 25, five are on Rs 20, four on Rs 16, five on Rs 15, six on Rs 13 and 144 teachers on Rs 12 and two on Rs 11. All the teachers under the Board are being paid allowance at Rs 4 per mensem and about 50 teachers draw in addition Rs 2 allowance, funds permitting. About 20 additional teachers are expected to be required for the existing schools in the ensuing year.

If the pay of existing teachers is proposed to be revised, the total number of teachers whose pay will be effected showing the proposed scales of pay and the extra provision made for the purpose.

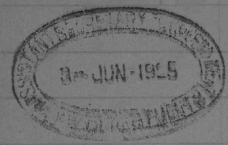
There is no proposal to revise the salaries of teachers without financial assistance from Government.

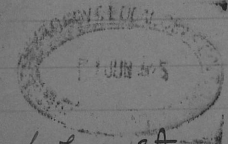

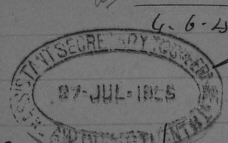

3. The budget closes with a deficit of Rs. 3033.

(iii) With reference to the budget approved in G.O. No. 875 Law (Edn) of 29.5.24 the Board's contribution from its general revenues to the elementary education fund should be raised to Rs 6320 for each of the years 1923-24 and 1924-25.

(iv) The resulting deficit should be avoided by reducing the expenditure.
