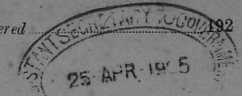

- The credit taken for Govt contribution under Sec. 37 in the R.E for 1924-25 should be reduced to Rs.7062 with reference to G.O.No. 309 Mis. Law (Edn), dated 3-3-25, and the excess amount paid in G.O. No. 653 Mis Law (Edn), dated 29-4-24 has been adjusted in G.O.No. 165 Law (Edn) dated 5-2-25
- With reference to sub para (1) of G.O.No. 725 Law (Edn) dated 9-5-24 the credit taken for Govt contribution under the proviso to sec. 37 in the actuals of 23-24 should be reduced to Rs. 22421. The credit taken under the same item in the R.E. for 1924-25 and in the B.E. for 1925-26 should be revised as shewn below the amount in the latter case being liable to subsequent adjustment with reference to the savings, if any,

4. Credit should be taken in the actuals of 23-24 for a sum of Rs. 230 as "appropriation from Govt. grant unspent balance" with reference to sub para (ii) of G.O.No. 725 Law (Edn) dated 9-5-24 and in the R.E. for 1924-25 for a sum of Rs. 300 adjusted in G.O.No. 165 Law (Edn) dated 5-2-25

5. The Board's contribution from its general revenues was fixed at Rs. 7000 for each of the years 23-24 and 24-25 in the Budget ~~allowed~~ approved in G.O.No. 725 Law (Edn) dated 9-5-24. The Board has reduced the same to Rs. 5250 being the contribution said to have been fixed by Govt in its normal budget.

6. It is observed from the annexure to the budget that the Board proposes to open five new school and to entertain four additional teachers on Rs. 19 per mensem in the existing schools during 25-26 but the provision made in the B.E. for 1925-26 under "staff-salaries and allowance-masters" is the same as that of 24-25. It is not clear how the Board proposes to meet the cost of these new items. The B.E. for 1925-26 does not close with any credit balance.

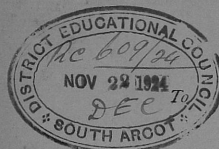

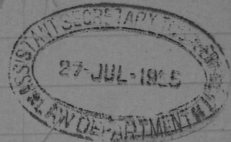
