2. Revised Estimate of 1924-25.

Credits - Office and Establishment. With reference to the

actual amount paid during the year in G.Os Nos. 672, Law (Education) dated 2nd May 1924 and 276 Law (Education) dated 20th February 1925, the credit taken may be raised to Rs 2136/-

Debits. In their order No. 276, Law (Education) dated 20th February 1925, Government have stated that the sum of Rs 404/- paid as further payment included a sum of Rs 400/- for the printing of the combined list. But from the particulars furnished, it is observed that no provision has been made for

for the printing of the combined list. According to the particulars furnished on the debit side under 'Office and establishment' the accounts of the council will close with a balance of Rs 399 on 1st April 1925. As the G.O. sanctioning the further payment quoted above was issued after the budget was prepared by the Council, no provision appears to have been made in the Revised estimate of 1924-25 for the printing of the combined list.

Salaries of Clerks. In G.O.No. 225 Mis. Law (Education) dated 18th February 1924, the Council was authorised to pay an allowance of Rs 10 per mensem to the headclerk of the Council's office subject to the condition that the total budget provision for the pay of clerks and peons is not exceeded.

In sanctioning the budget estimate of the Council for 1924-25, Government have also stated that no additional allotment can be sanctioned for meeting the expenditure on account of the payment of this allowance. The President, however, -- explains the circumstances under which the budget provision has to be exceeded. I recommend that the provision made for 1082/- in the Revised Estimate of 1924-25 may be allowed to stand.

3. Budget Estimate of 1925-26.

(i) The credits taken under grants-in-aid may be tentatively allowed to stand subject to the provision of funds.

(ii) Debits.

(a) Salaries of clerks. The provision made in the Budget Estimate may be reduced to Rs 1032 with reference to the orders contained in G.O.No. 1498 Mis. Law (Education) dated 23rd September 1924.

(b) Travelling allowance of Members. No explanation has been furnished for the increased provision made. With reference to the provision allowed by Government in the budget estimate of the Council for 1924-25 the provision made in the budget estimate for 1925-26 may be reduced to Rs 500.

(c)

(c) Postage charges and purchase of Stationery The provision made in the budget estimate under the respective items may be reduced to Rs 150 and Rs 250 with reference to the amounts allowed in the budget estimate for 1924-25.

(d) House rent. The Council is reported to be not in favour of the amalgamation of its office with that of the District Educational Officer, suggested in para 2 of G.O.No. 225, Law (Education) dated 18th February 1924. The provision made under 'rents' both in the Revised Estimate and in the Budget Estimate may stand subject to the sanction of Government being obtained before incurring the expenditure.

(e) With reference to the above remarks the credit taken for Rs 2602 under 'Office and Establishment' in the budget estimate may be reduced to Rs 2252/-

2. The amount provided under "Teaching grant" in the budget estimate for the year 1925-26 is provisional and liable to revision.

3. Under "Office and establishment expenses," credit has been allowed for a sum of Rs 2,032/- Against this, the Council has already received a sum of Rs 1,732/- under the Sanction

requested to report the balance due
to the Council in the current year

the expenditure on account of
the payment of an allowance
of Rs 10/- per member to the
head clerk of the office of the D.E.C.
The action of the Council in having
incurred an expenditure of Rs 50/-
on account of the payment of the
allowance to the head clerk, in
excess of the total budget provi-
sion for the pay of clerks and
peons, is approved as a special case.

address the Government separately on
the question of renting a building
for the accommodation of the Office of the D.E.C.
