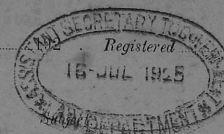

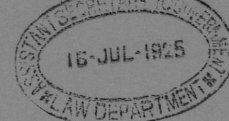

It is observed from the D.P.'s letter on p 2 C.F. that there is only 1 student in Form V. The D.P. however says that the graduate assistant in addition to the headmistress is essential for teaching all the subjects in the IV and V forms in the school.
