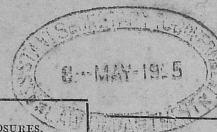

Consideration of Government. I therefore request that Government may be pleased to sanction the proposal with necessary allotment at their earliest convenience.

Read letter dated 15-2-25 of M.R.Ry A.S.Sahajanandam Avergall correspondent and manager of Nandanar aided elementary school and Member of this District Educational Council submitting for consideration of the Council a proposal requesting to pay half an anna per boy per diem from the Council funds for feeding poor boys studying in the Nandanar aided school which is the only adi-dravida higher elementary school in this district.

The Council recommends the application for the favourable consideration of the Government.

Copy of letter dated 15-2 25 of M.R.Ry M.S.Sahajnamam Avl.,
to the President, District Educational Council, South Arcot.

I, Sahajanandawami, correspondent of the Nandanar school,
and a member of your Council, beg leave to move the following
proposition in your Council and requests that it may be favourably
considered for the following reasons:-

1) The Nandanar school is the only adi-dravida institution
in this district having classes up to and including the 7th
standard and the progress made in this school is also already
known to this Council. There are over 100 adi-dravida boys in
this school. I have been trying my level best to equip this
school with all the required materials both by private donations
and Government grants. In spite of this the parents of these
boys, who are very poor, whose sole occupation is farming and
cutting and selling grass which could hardly give them a living,
find it extremely difficult to send their children to school and
expect them also to work with them to give some food to their
youngsters who attend the school. So, unless, some kind of
encouragement is shown to them by giving them at least ~~half~~ $\frac{1}{2}$ anna
worth of food viz., ^a Knji to them every day at noon time, thereby
relieving their parents to some extent it will be extremely diffi-
cult in these hard days to make these poor adi-dravida boys who have
little or no education at present, to go to school every day and
learn at least the 3 rs.

I therefore request that this Council may be pleased to
sanction at the rate of at least $\frac{1}{2}$ anna per boy per diem and thus
encourage the poor boys of this school. I may also be permitted
to state that such a procedure is being followed in the Educational
Council at Madras. Even if there is no rule for giving such
a grant, I request that as a special case at least, this Council
may kindly consider this and grant the required amount.

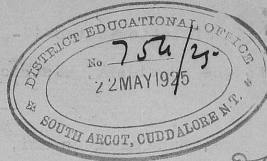
