In continuation of my letter R.C.No.2957 D/23

dated 15-7-25 I have the honour to submit for inclusion in the list of approved works maintained in pursuance of G.O. No.572 L.E., dated 10-5-22, The following two schemes relating to the High and Training Schools at Pasumalai

- (1) Installation of electric lights
- (2) Installation of a pumping plant

2. I submit herewith 2 estimates amounting to Rs.17942 and Rs.12382 respectively for the above works.

The

The Electric^{al} Inspector who has inspected the works states that he is satisfied that the electric installation and the pumping plant are composed of good material and are well installed.

3. In regard to the estimate for the electric installation, the Electrical Inspector states that the sum of Rs.985 shown as contingencies should be struck out as it cannot be substantiated and the estimate accepted for Rs.16,957 only.

4. The estimate for the pumping plant includes a sum of Rs.5000 for digging a well in regard to which the Government have already been addressed in my letter quoted in para 1 above. Deducting this amount from the estimate, the cost of the works comes to Rs.7382 and the Electrical Inspector recommends the acceptance of this estimate.

5. I recommend that the two works mentioned in para 1 supra may be approved by Government at a cost of Rs.16,957 and Rs.7382 respectively and sanction accorded to their inclusion in the list of approved works.

6. It has to be remarked that the provisions of para 57(iv) of the Grant-in-Aid Code have not been observed. It is stated, however, that the matter was explained in person to the permanent Director, who was prepared to consider grant if, as is the case, the work was properly carried out.

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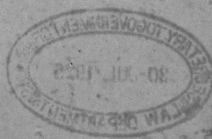
