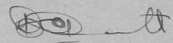

Under Article 156 of the Civil Accounts Code, Volume I, the Government sanctioned the payment of an advance of Rs. 4,200 (Four thousand two hundred only) to Mr. R.M. Statham, Officer on special duty, for the purchase of a motor car.

2. The advance should not be drawn until it is actually required . It will be recovered in 35 monthly instalments of Rs. 117 each and a further instalment of Rs. 105.

3. Interest at five per cent a year will be charged on the amount of ~~cash~~ the advance and will be recovered in accordance with G.O.No. 624 Finance, ~~CCO~~ dated 25-8-24.
