Sir,

I have the honour to submit below a scheme for the introduction of a weaving class in the Malabar Mission Training School, Nettur.

1. Instruction is proposed to be given to about 110 students under training in batches of about 10 at a time each batch receiving half-a-day's instruction per week.

3. Mr.Porrett who examined the scheme estimates

the recurring charges at Rs.500 and the non-recurring charges at Rs.520 as per details noted in the margin.

Weaving is specially recommended as Nettur is reported to be a weaving centre.

4. The District Educational Officer reports that the present financial position

of the Mission is not favourable to admit of a half or even a quarter of the scheme being borne by it. It is however understood that the management is willing to provide the accommodation necessary for the class and to bear one half of the recurring charges of the proposed weaving class during the 2nd and succeeding years if Government should meet the entire initial and recurring expenditure during the 1st year.

5. I accordingly recommend that the initial cost of Rs.520 and the recurring expenditure of Rs.42 for one month may be met from Provincial funds.

6. A reappropriation statement to meet the charge during the remaining month of the current year is also, submitted herewith.

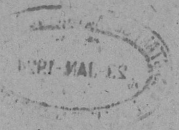

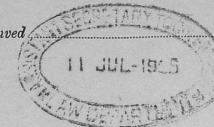

Dear Sir,

Ref: Your No. 1476/23 dated 11-5-25, and reminder dated 8-6-25, just received-Vocational Education, Malabar Mission Training School, Nettur. -----

Some confusion seems to have befallen this correspondence on 7-12-1923 under the above reference number you wrote asking me to report "Whether the School is willing to bear half the recurring charges of the proposed weaving class during the second and succeeding years if Government undertake to bear the whole of the initial and recurring expenditure during the first year and half the recurring charges for the succeeding years". I replied, I believe, on 18-12-1923, but my record is defective and this date is approximate, accepting this offer. I believe you wrote a few days later to the Director of Public Instruction intimating our acceptance of the offer. Ever since, I have been awaiting the Government's reply.

During the eighteen months since this correspondence was initiated, the Mission finances have become increasingly difficult and it has become exceedingly difficult to carry on this expensive Training School. Consequently, while we should be heartily glad to introduce this form of Vocational Education, and in fact have excellent facilities for doing so if funds could be found, I fear that the utmost that we can do will be to bear half the recurring charges if the Government will bear half the initial charges. In present circumstances, the initial cost is prohibitive for us.

The Correspondent of the
Malabar Mission Training School,
Nettur, reports that the manage-
ment can bear only one-half of the
recurring charges of the scheme at
the moment. It asks the Government
to meet the entire
non-recurring charges. The D.E.O.

is of opinion that the finances of the Mission are not favourable to admit of it bearing a half or even a quarter of the cost of the scheme. The recurring and non-recurring charges of the scheme amount to Rs. ³²⁵~~292~~ and Rs. 520 respectively. In view of the inability of the management to bear any portion of the initial cost Govt may pay the full non-recurring charge. Neither is reported to be a good wearing Centre.

Out of a provision of Rs. 1,15,000 for new scheme of manual training provided in the current year's budget Estimate Rs. 71,200 is for schools under local bodies and private management. The details for this amount and the expenditure incurred till now are shown below:—

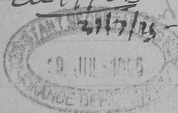
