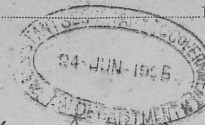

Copy of letter R.C. No. 5/M.D. of 1925-1926 dated 9th June 1925 from the Correspondent, the High School, Srirangam, to the District Educational Officer, Trichinopoly.

With reference to your A.C. No. 733 A/1925 dated 2-6-'25 communicating G.O. No. 854 Law (Education) Department dated 19-5-1925, I have the honour to inform you that the management is absolutely unable to bear any portion of the non-recurring charges of the scheme for the introduction of Manual Training in Weaving in the school, under the following circumstances. The school has no endowment of its own. It is at present maintained entirely by the fee income of the school. The financial statements for 1924-25 and 1923-24 will show how the school has been working at a deficit. As the management has already raised about 40000/- as donations from local gentlemen and from friends residing outside, it is at present unable to get more from them.

I have, therefore, the honour to request you to kindly recommend to the Government that they may be pleased to bear the entire non-recurring charges of the scheme submitted by us for opening weaving classes in our schools.

Please see G.O. No. 854 Law (Edn) D 19.5.25 and the notes thereto. The management of the school has clearly explained its inability to meet any portion of the non-recurring charges for the introduction of manual training in weaving in the school. The school has been working at a deficit for the years 1923-24 and 1924-25. The non-recurring charges amount to Rs. 2300 and the recurring charges to Rs. 470 (charges for 8 months). There is provision for the scheme in the budget estimate for the current year.

Under rule 3 of the rules relating to grant-in-aid of manual training Govt may sanction a grant equivalent to the entire non-recurring cost in this case.

The facts stated on page 2.C.F. justify the concession

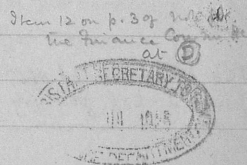

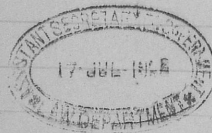

In asking for a provision of 1.15 lakhs
for new Schemes of Manual Training
Law (Edu) provided only for a half
grant of Rs 1180 for non recurring and
Rs 315 for recurring charges for weaving
classes in the Srirangam High School.
They now propose to sanction a full
grant of Rs 2,360 for non recurring
expenditure i.e. Rs 1180 in excess of the budget
provision.

In some other similar cases also,
grants in excess of the budget provision
have been sanctioned ~~recently~~ and
the Law (Edu) dept. stated that the
extra expenditure in these cases would
be met from the savings in the provision
for recurring expenditure. Full year's

has been made in the budget but in many
cases only 8 months charges would be
incurred as the new Schemes were
introduced only after the reopening of
the schools. It seems necessary at this
stage to be assured that the budget
provision will not be exceeded. Law (Edu)
may first be requested to note the total
amount of expenditure so far authorised
in the current year against the budget
provision of 1.15 lakhs for new Schemes
and to state whether the savings
referred to will be sufficient to meet
the extra expenditure in this and in
similar cases.

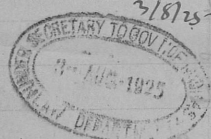
