Submitted.

2. The sum of Rs 25804 taken credit for as Government grants under the proviso to Section 37 in the Revised Estimate for 1924-25 should be reduced ~~in~~ by Rs 405, the unspent balance adjusted in G.O.No. 165, Law (Education) dated 5th February 1925. This should be shown separately in the Revised Estimate for 1924-25 as appropriation from Government grant unspent balance. The credit taken for provincial contribution under the proviso to section 37 in the Budget Estimate for 1925-26 is liable to subsequent adjustment with reference to the savings, if any, out of the subsidy paid in G.O.No. 1598, Law (Education) dated 16th October 1924.

3. The sum of Rs 3000 taken credit for as Government grants under 'Capital' in the Revised Estimate for 1924-25 represents the amount paid in G.O.No. 1598 Law (Education) dated 16th October 1924 towards the equipment of the new schools.

4. On the debit side of the budget under capital the board has shown Rs 9000 in the revised estimate for 1924-25 against an entry of Rs 3000 under the same item on the credit side. In the Budget Estimate for 1925-26 a sum of Rs 20,000/- is shown without any corresponding entry on the credit side. It is observed that the expenditure is to be met by appropriation from the ordinary receipts. The Board should have indicated the same on the credit side.

5. The Board may be requested to consult the District Educational Officer in regard to the opening of new schools.

The Board has proposed to open 63 new elementary schools in the current year itself as detailed below.

(a) 50 schools sanctioned in G.O. No. 1598 dated 15-10-24, of which 20 schools (included in No. 1 above) have already been started. The remaining 30 schools will start work from January 1925.

(b) The Board, in resolution no. 160 dated 17-12-24, has sanctioned the opening of 32 school. Another Adi-Dravid school has also been sanctioned in G.O. resolution no. 168 dated 17-12-24. Speedy arrangements are in progress to start the schools as early as possible.

3. Total number of teachers employed in all the schools under the management of the local body on the date of submission of the budget, the scales of pay in force & the number of teachers in each scale.

The Board employed in all Board schools on the date of submission of the budget - 155 teachers.

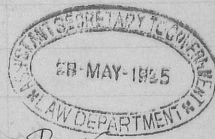

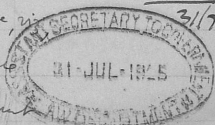

The Budget Estimate of the Elementary Education fund under the Control of the Zahir Board, Ballachi for the year 1925-26 is approved subject to the following remarks:-

(i) The sum of Rs 25,804 taken credit for as forest grant under the proviso to Section 3) of the Madras Elementary Education fund; 1920 in the Revised Estimate for

1924-25 should be reduced by ~~Rs.~~ 4005, the unspent balance adjusted in G.O. no. 185 (Law Education) of 5.2.25. This should be shown separately as appropriation from Government grant unspent balance. The credit taken for provincial contribution under the same head in the Budget Estimate for 1925-26 is liable to subsequent adjustment with reference to the savings, if any, out of the subsidy paid in G.O. no. 1598 (Law Education) of 16.10.1924.

In the Budget Estimate for 1925-26, a sum of Rs. 2000 is shown under the same head without any corresponding entry on the credit side. It is observed that the expenditure is to be met by appropriation from the ordinary receipts. The Board should have indicated the same on the credit side.
