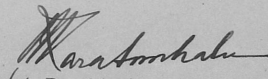

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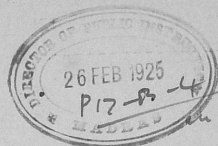

Proceedings of the District Educational Council, Trichinopoly passed at a meeting held on 17th. January 1925.

1. Establishment. (a) The Allotment under establishment may be increased so that the clerks of this office may be given a raise. Read:- Draft Budget -- District Educational Council, Trichinopoly -- 1925--1926. 5-35-14-50-1-40. If the Government is not pleased to sanction additional allotment for the purpose it is requested that the Council may be authorised to transfer necessary funds from the disbursements under other heads except Grants-in-Aid for the purpose.

2. Teaching grants:- (b) Resolution No.524. 95,000/- Budget for 1925-26 is necessary to meet additional expenditure for payment of teaching grants to new schools to be admitted to aid for 1925-26.

The draft budget with the following two alterations is approved:- According to the type design each year aid may be sanctioned so that the position of Government schools will be well satisfied gradually, and the draft budget for 1925-26 is therefore to Rs.95,000/- instead of Rs. 92,000/- ., and

(1) Allotment under Teaching Grant be raised to Rs. 95,000/- instead of Rs. 92,000/- ., and

(11) Allotment under Building Grant be raised to Rs. 5,000/- instead of Rs.4,000/- .

4. Grants for furniture, books and appliances, etc. (c) The perusal of the report of the inspection committee of the inspecting officers it is seen that many schools in such areas are in need of the simple appliances such as black-boards, pillars, etc. To supply this need a sum of Rs.1000/- is budgetted. Remarks on the following heads of the budget of this Council for the year 1925-26.

1. Establishment. (a) The allotment under establishment charges may be increased so that the clerks of this office may be given, with retrospective effect, the salary according to the scale fixed for Government servants in the Lower grade 35-35-1½-50-1-1-60. If the Government is not pleased to sanction additional allotment for the purpose it is requested that the Council may be authorised to transfer necessary funds from the allotments under other heads except Grants-in-Aid for the purpose.

2. Teaching grants:- (b) The amount of Rs. 95,000/- budgetted for is necessary to meet additional expenditure for payment of teaching grants to new schools to be admitted to aid for 1925-26.

3. Building grants:- (c) Considering the financial difficulty at least for five new buildings according to the type design each year aid may be sanctioned so that the question of accommodation may be well satisfied gradually; and the amount budgetted for 1925-26 is therefore necessary.

4. Grants for furniture, books and appliances, etc. (d) From a close perusal of the several inspection reports of the inspecting officers it is seen that many schools in rural areas are in need of the simple appliances such as black-boards, pictures, etc. To supply this need a sum of Rs. 1000/- is budgetted for 1925-26.

5. Equipment renewals--Furniture and apparatus. (e) Provision has been made for the purchase of Magic lanterns and slides as suggested in the report of this Council on the condition of Elementary Education for 1922-23.
