- (b) The Council has already sanctioned Building grants for some of the schools and they are pending payment for want of completion. and some more applications for grants will be forthcoming.
- (c) Many of the private aided schools are not equipped properly with furniture and the Council desires to provide them.
- (d) The allotment asked for under Travelling allowances is considered necessary to carry on the work of the Council especially.
- (e) On account of increased postal rates and increase of correspondence, allotment under stamps has been increased.
